Other details for Fellowship/Clinical Visit: The Norman Capener Spinal Fellowship is an established one year training opportunity for post CCT orthopaedic and neurosurgical trainees from the UK and overseas. Fellows gain experience with a wide range of techniques and specifically anterior lumbar surgery. The Fellowship provides trainees with a good foundation in the generality of adult and paediatric spinal surgery with experienced mentors and a wide case-mix. Elective and emergency extra-dural

specialist and non-specialist surgery is undertaken in Exeter which is a regional referral centre with 6 Consultant Orthopaedic Spinal Surgeons.
